General Information Sheet

2025 Vancouver E2 Bible Camp – Sunday, August 24th – Wednesday, August 27th

General Guidelines:

- 1) All students should complete online registration by July 12, 2025
- 2) All students are required to attend the entire Bible Camp on a full-time basis. This requirement is to help the students to focus and minimize any distractions. Special exceptions must first be approved by the Bible Camp coordinators.
- 3) The Bible Camp check-in begins on <u>Sunday, August 24th at 3PM.</u> Out-of-town students should arrive either the day before or on the day before registration.
- 4) The Bible Camp will end on Wednesday, August 27th at 8PM.
- 5) Prepare yourself spiritually, mentally and physically before coming to Bible Camp by praying more, reading the Bible daily, spending less time with TV, movies, internet, video games and secular music, and having adequate rest.
- 6) Dress code is conservative, church attire. The following is not appropriate: sleeveless or see-through tops, low necklines, shorts/skirts falling above the knee, low-risers, tight or baggy pants, and any clothing showing the belly button or underwear.
- 7) Appropriate hairstyle and hair-color are required. Flip-flops and slippers should not be worn during class time.
- 8) Use of smartphone or cell phone is not permitted during the Bible Camp. If possible, please leave the smartphone or cell phone at home. You may leave your smartphone or cell phone with the Bible Camp coordinators for safekeeping until the end of the Bible Camp. If parents have to contact the students, please call the hosting church.
- 9) All personal gaming devices, mp3 players, mobile devices (iPads, iPhones, Androids), games, books, toys, and gadgets are to be left at home. Cell phones will be collected before the start of the Bible Camp and returned after the closing ceremony.
- 10) Be a child of God. Respect and honour one another. Pray earnestly. Learn the words of God. Respect and follow all regulations. Experience God Himself.

Lodging:

- 1) Sleeping bags and pillows will be provided for out-of-town students.
- 2) Out-of-town students will need to contact the hosting church to arrange for accommodation before and/or after the convocation.
- 3) Local students must notify the Bible Camp coordinators if accommodation is needed after the convocation...
- 4) Local church will provide soap, shampoos and conditioners, and toothpaste. Hangers and hair-dryers will be available.
- 5) All students must reside on the church premise throughout the duration of the event.
