REGISTRATION AND PARENTAL CONSENT

- 1. Complete registration form and submit to Sis. Jenna Ho (jenna.k.ho@gmail.com) by **November 16th, 2024** (both digital or paper copy are acceptable).
- 2. All students must meet the minimum age requirement as of December 31st, 2024.
- 3. If you have medical insurance coverage, please bring a copy of the insurance card with you.
- 4. All allergies and medical conditions must be disclosed in the registration form. Please label all medications clearly with the student's name and dosage instruction. The SSC workers will safekeep all medications brought by the students.

GENERAL

- 1. Registered students are expected to arrive punctually to register on **Saturday, December 21st, 2024 at 7:00pm**. Dinner will only be provided for non-local students and workers.
- 2. The convocation will end on **Saturday, December 28th, 2024 at 10:00** am. The Holy Communion sacrament will be conducted during the Sabbath afternoon service followed by thanksgiving offering.
- 3. All students must attend the SSC on a full-time basis in-person. This requirement enables students to focus and minimize any distractions (special exceptions must first be approved by SSC Coordinators).
- 4. Dress code is conservative, church attire. The following are not appropriate: sleeveless or see-through tops, low necklines, shorts/skirts above the knees, low-riders, tight or baggy pants, clothing that shows the belly button or underwear, and flip-flops/slippers during class time. Appropriate hairstyles and hair colour are required.
- 5. Bring appropriate attire for Holy Communion.
- 6. In the effort to minimize distractions, smartphones are collected during event registration; usage must be approved by the coordinators/counselors. They will be returned after the Sabbath service.
- 7. The SSC workers reserve the right to arrange the seating plan of any student using laptop/tablet for notetaking and safe keep the devices for any student found abusing the devices.
- 8. There will be no open picture time until the conclusion of the convocation. Each student will receive a copy of the SSC group picture.
- 9. All personal electronics, books, and toys (including stuffies) are to be left at home.
- 10. The church will prepare plenty of healthy food. Please don't bring any additional snacks.
- 11. Prepare yourself spiritually, mentally and physically before coming to SSC by praying more, reading the Bible daily; make sure each participant has adequate rest.

COVID-19 SAFETY

- 1. We will all be taking a COVID-19 rapid antigen test midweek.
- 2. Minimize unnecessary high-risk exposure leading up to the event (3-5 days beforehand). Registrants who are considered as close contact to any positive cases or who have developed COVID-like symptoms should contact the event coordinators before attending the event.
- 3. Any local students with COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home until they recover. Non-local students will be quarantined to maintain a hygienic environment.

LODGING

- 1. All participants should lodge at church and remain within the church premises at all times.
- 2. Local students are recommended to bring their own sleeping bags and pillows. If there is a need for the church to provide, please indicate this in the registration form.
- 3. Bring enough change of clothes for one week. Don't forget towels, toiletry, and flip-flop/slippers. Laundry can be arranged if necessary.
- 4. Accommodation is only provided 1 day before and/or after the convocation; otherwise, advance notice is required for the local Church Council approval.
